I want to bring to your attention a community engagement opportunity which may arise with your local Rotary club in November from their 2023 *Saying NO to Domestic and Family Violence and YES to Respectful Relationships* campaign, that they will leverage off the *16 days of Activism Against Gender Based Violence* campaign.

Each year, from 25 November to 10 December, the QPS supports the internationally recognised *16 days of Activism Against Gender Based Violence* campaign. The 25th of November is recognised as the *International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women*. The 16 days concludes on *International Human Rights Day* in drawing attention to violence against women and children being a violation of human rights.

As you may be aware, Rotary is a well-recognised global humanitarian organisation; administering activities throughout the world and local police and Rotary clubs have often come together in community events designed to raise awareness of domestic and family violence.

Recently, the QPS was approached by Rotary Districts 9620, 9640 and 9560 that cover Queensland, Northern NSW and the Northern Territory to consider a formalised partnership.

While there is no formal partnership arrangement with the above Rotary Districts yet, if your local Rotary club reaches out to your station promoting events in November, I ask you to consider them like any other community policing event that your district undertakes.
